



HOW TO ADD LE WEEK-END HYPERLINKED IMAGE TO YOUR GMAIL SIGNATURE

THEN, FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS

1. Click on **Settings** (the gear icon) from the upper right-hand corner then click on **See all settings**. Scroll down until you see **Signature**. Select **+ Create new** or edit your existing one by clicking on


